Sample itinerary

Day 1

Wheelchairs accessible pick up and transfer to a downtown accessible hotel

Rest of the afternoon at leisure (D)

Day 2

Hotel pick up (9:30 AM)

Today you will participate in a scenic tour of Bridgetown the capital city.

Highlights: Government House, Jewish Synagogue, Pelican village shopping centre (B, L)

Day 3 Hotel pick up

Today we explore Harrison Cave. Relax in the cool breeze and soak up the Caribbean sun. Marvel at the lush green vegetation that surrounds this unique hideaway.

Board the tramcar and descend into a world of stalactite/mites under the watchful eyes of you local tour guide, here you can marvel at the clear freshwater pools and caverns and learn of the unique filtration system that contributes to the local water system.

Overnight at host hotel (B, L)

Day 4

Enjoy a full day boat tour of some of Barbados swimming spots.

Enjoy a scenic view of some of Barbados premier hotels and Villas

Swim with the turtles in an environmentally protected area; later enjoy a sumptuous lunch at a local diner, while you are there, share some travel stories with the friendly Bajans. (L)

Day 5

Hotel pick up (10:0am)

Today we explore the costal and inner regions of the island.

Highlights: Sugar cane mill, limited stop at the green monkey petting station then onwards to Bathsheba, an international surfing region. Here you can shop and enjoy cool glasses of rum punch as you haggle with the local plying their handmade crafts. Later enjoy a sumptuous lunch complete with the Bajan favourite Flying fish, roti, pepper pot stew, jump-up and a cold glass of banks beer. (L)

Day 6 Morning at leisure.

Afternoon pick up and transfer to St Lawrence gap. Explore the local watering hole and craft stands; catch up on you electronic communication at the local internet café. Enjoy a delicious lunch at one of the local hotel/restaurants such as Pisces restaurant. Barbados boasts some of the world's renowned fine dining establishment, hence their unique award as the only Zagat -rated fine dining Country in the Caribbean.

Transfer to host hotel

Evening pick up and transfer to Oistin's Fish Fry

Later transfer to host hotel (D)

Day 7
